I have breakfast. \rightarrow I had breakfast.

I **do** my homework. \rightarrow I **did** my homework.

I don't get up early. \rightarrow I didn't get up early.

I don't go to school.

I didn't go to school.

NOT I didn't got up early. / I didn't went to school. etc.

Do you have breakfast? \rightarrow **Did** you have breakfast?

Do you **do** your homework? → **Did** you **do** your homework?

NOT Did you had breakfast? / Did you did your homework? etc.

• Remember word order in questions: auxiliary, subject, base form of verb: Did you get up early? question word, auxiliary, subject, base form of verb: What time did you get up?

O did / didn't

We use did / didn't to make questions and negatives in the past, e.g.,

Did you go to class?

I didn't have breakfast this morning.

Here, did / didn't = an auxiliary verb.

But did can also be a normal verb, e.g., I did my homework on the weekend.
