Appendix A

Speaking and Writing Scoring Rubrics

This section contains all the rubrics used by raters to score Speaking and Writing section responses. There are two different rubrics used to score the Speaking section, and two used to score the Writing section.

Speaking question 1 is scored using the Independent Speaking Rubric, while questions 2–4 are scored using the Integrated Speaking Rubric. Writing question 1 is scored using the Integrated Writing Rubric, while question 2 is scored using the Independent Writing Rubric.

The chart below shows the main features of responses that must be considered when assigning a score.
