Desert island survivors

Scene 1 Emergency landing!

- Narrator A class of children from New Zealand are on a school trip. They were flying in a small plane across the Pacific Ocean when there was a problem with their plane. They had to land on the beach of a small desert island.
- Pilot I've spoken to the rescue services and told them where we are. They know which island we're on. They're going to send a boat for us. It will be here in two days.



Child 1 Two days?!

Script

Child 2 But there's nothing to eat! Or drink! And where will we sleep? (Everyone looks at each other in alarm.)

- Scene 2 Plan of action!
- **Teacher** OK! We need to find food, and water, and a place to sleep. We will make three groups. (The first group is looking for something to drink.)
- **Child 3** Look! There's a small stream. Let's follow it. The water will be cleaner further up. (15 minutes later)
- Child 4 Look! There's lots of fresh water here!
- Child 1 Yes, and look! There are water pots!
- Child 2 How strange! Where did they come from? (The second group is looking for food.)
- Child 5 Look! There's a coconut tree. And there are lots of coconuts on the ground. We can eat those.
- Child 6 Great! What else?
- Child 7 There's a banana tree! But the bananas are too high.
- Child 8 Yes, but look! There's a wooden ladder to climb up to get the bananas!
- Child 5 How strange! Where did it come from? (The third group is looking for somewhere to sleep.)
- Child 9 There's a cave over there! If it rains, we won't get wet!
- **Child 10** Let's go and look inside. (Inside the cave)
- Child 11 It's very big.
- Child 12 Look at this! There's a message on the wall!
- **Child 9** If you seek a hidden treasure,

That will give you lots of pleasure,

Then find a flag and where it flies,

That's where you'll find my precious prize!

(Children look at each other in amazement.)



- Scene 3 Back on the beach
- TeacherHello, everyone! What did you find?(The first group holds up pots of water.)
- Child 1 We found some water!
- **Child 2** And we found these old pots by the river! But where did they come from? (The second group holds up coconuts and bananas.)
- Child 5 We found some food!
- Child 6 And we also found an old wooden ladder up a tree! But where did it come from?
- Teacher So, someone lived on this island before!
- Child 9 And we found a cave to sleep in! And we also found a message on the cave wall!
- Child 10 It said: If you seek a hidden treasure, Which will give you lots of pleasure, Then find a flag and where it flies, That's where you'll find my precious prize!
- Child 11 There's some treasure buried on the island!
- Child 7 Let's find it!
- TeacherOK, children! First, let's eat and drink and then go to sleep.
The treasure will still be there tomorrow!
- Scene 4 The day of the treasure hunt!
- Narrator The next day ...
- Child 1 Today we're going to find the treasure!
- Child 2 I can't wait!
- Child 6 But how can we find the flag?
- **Child 9** Let's walk to the top of the island. We can see everything from there! (The children walk to the top of the island.)
- Child 12 Look! There's a flag! It's on the beach on the other side of the island!
- **Child 5** Let's go! (The children are on the beach looking at the flag.)
- Child 3 The treasure must be buried below the flag. Let's dig!

(All the children dig away the sand.)

- Child 8 Look! There's a box!
- Child 10 We've found the treasure!
- Child 4 Let's open the box! (Slowly they open the box.)
- Child 11 It's a guitar ...
- Child 7 A guitar? But, that isn't treasure!





Scene 5 Going home


Narrator The boat has arrived to collect everyone and take them home.
